Doug asks about the equipment list for Simran @ RDEK for go-boxes. List to be provided to Simran for RDEK for their Emergency Management Program.

Jeff asks about repeater in Sparwood. Gavin reports SparComm has a 2 metre repeater set up in Sparwood, which is tagged to go up to repeater site. We gave them a controller to use, but we need to determine if they want to continue to be the O/O of the site.

Gavin reports that SAR group is interested in HAM radio and our group specifically. Doug reports he attended the one in Cranbrook and it was interesting as to which groups were present.

Tim reports that Doug has the Facebook group up and running. Tim reports that he is trying to find a CMS that works well. Doug suggests checking TechSoup. Tim to investigate further. Doug reports that he will be doing an interview with Dennis Walker on 107.5 FM on February 7th, regarding our club and the course.

- d) RDEK update

 - b. CBT grant was denied.
 - c. RDEK budgeting \$15000 for EKARC upgrades.
 - d. Leaving room for next training session of a few thousand dollars.
 - e. Emergency Radio Communications operator course to be potentially held on April 12th Wednesday, at EOC. Course length of eight hours. Minimum of 12 people required to run the course.
 - f. EOC Essentials is prerequisite for the Radio Communications course.
