# **MINUTES**

Meeting called to order at 19:17.

#### 1. ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Nothing to be added. Adoption of agenda motioned by Tom VE7TGA, seconded by Chris VE7UTV.

#### 3. MINUTES – ADOPTION

Minutes motioned to adopt from August meeting by Gavin VE7GSJ, Jeff VE7JFX seconds.

#### 4. BUSINESS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

Minutes from August referred to investigating grant opportunities. Kevin VA7KJL suggests replacing Invermere Repeater equipment, purchase DMR repeater for Cranbrook (on Baker).

Gavin reports that the email sent to club requesting feedback for ideas for using grant money garnered several responses with no consensus. Some suggestions about APRS, some suggestions about DMR. Lance mentioned training opportunities. Dan VE7MRP suggested DMR repeater based on retrofit Bridgecom repeaters. DMR would likely need Internet feed.

Tom VE7TGA suggested Yaesu System Fusion and DMR combo repeater.

Consensus seems to be leaning toward DMR. Gavin to bring it up with Repeater Committee. Doug asks about Invermere repeater, Gavin to confirm with Repeater Committee re: updating radios in Invermere to bring VE7RIN up to same level as the rest of the repeaters.

Jeff VE7JFX asks about Sparwood, to be taken offline by Gavin, as request is for used equipment and grant money must be used towards new equipment.

Jeff VE7JFX asks about RDEK possibly sponsoring/offsetting cost of club repeater insurance.

Doug to take Bridgecom cable issue as action item.

Lance VE7LOC asks about repeater ID on VE7CAP (Baker Mt.) and if it can be changed. Jeff VE7JFX asks about people who used to check in from Creston, Gavin explains that the CTCSS tone has possibly limited a few people from accessing the repeater.

Frequency Committee – Dan VE7MRP repeats no new repeaters, status quo.

**EOC Coordination** – Kevin VA7KJL reports that he went to the last meeting at the EOC and spoke to Wayne Mercer. Kevin has asked if EOC would like to sponsor us for further education/training in how EOC operations work. Gavin asks for clarification about *where* the EOC building actually is, club determines that EOC is across from the "Old Firehall Pub". Address to be determined/shared.

Website Committee – Kevin VA7KJL reports website is working well and is to add a "Resources" tab.

**Net Control Committee** – Tim VE7LXC reports nothing much has changed, thanked Jeff VA7BAJ for taking over for Ken VE7NEK

Doug VA7QZ asks if anyone would like to present for the social meeting next month, Tim VE7LXC volunteers to do a presentation on SDR.
